DRIVING

In Greece, you drive on the right hand side of the road! As in the UK, you must use a hands free kit if you want to make a call on your phone. It is advisable to keep your driving license with you and keep any rental agreements in the car.

Beware of large buses, trucks and scooters lurking behind sharp corners - the roads are very bendy and can be very narrow. **DO NOT DRINK AND DRIVE.**

TELECOMMUNICATIONS

The international dialing code for Greece is **+30**. To call abroad from Greece, dial 00 followed by the relevant country code (e.g. **0044** for UK) - or **001** for the USA. Using the phone at your hotel can be very expensive. Public phone booths are available all over the island and phone cards can be purchased from kiosks, mini markets and OTE.

Please note that when calling the UK, omit the "0" prefix from the area code e.g. 0044 1753... as opposed to 0044 (0)1753.

MOBILE PHONES

Most places in Greece are covered by mobile networks - VODAFONE, WIND, COSMOTE, QTELECOM. They all use GSM networks and have roaming agreements with most international operators. However, VODAFONE & COSMOTE seem to have greater coverage, especially as far as islands are concerned. Network signals may fluctuate when driving around the island, so in case you are out of signal be patient and it should come back soon! Greek mobile numbers **DO NOT** have a '*0' at the beginning.

ELECTRICITY

The electricity supply in Greece is alternating current, 220-250 Volts, 50 cycles. Appliances for 110 or 120 volts may be operated by using step down transformers of 220-250 volts connected to each outlet.

DRUGS

Legislation in Greece is exactly the same as it is anywhere else. Possession of any drug in any quantity, including cannabis, will result in a custodial sentence.

TIPPING

By law a 13% service charge is added to the price of a meal. However, it is customary to leave an 8%-10% tip if the service was satisfactory.

SKOPELOS GENERAL INFORMATION

Skopelos Island belongs to the North Sporades complex of islands and is located between Skiathos and Alonissos. On reaching the port you will see Hora- town and capital of Skopelos- amphitheatrically built, with narrow uphill slab-paved alleys. It is worth walking them to admire the popular architecture of the houses with the old hanging balconies, the small bridges between the houses and the whitewashed streets*

On the northern part of the town, you will see the ruins of the Venetian Castle, built in the 13th century, as well as the church of Saint Athanassios, built in the 9th century. Visit also the Folklore Museum of Skopelos and the Vakratsa Museum.

The island has rich pine forests, which start from the top of the mountains and reach down to the sea. It has delicate beaches, sandy beaches, closed leeward bays and wild plant life too. The busiest places are Hora (Skopelos town in the south) and the villages of Stafylos, Panormos (ancient capital of the island) and Elios, with beautiful beaches. At the end of Stafylos beach you can find the wider and quieter beach called Velanio. Note that if you continue past the large rocks, you enter the only official nudist area.

Agnontas has also a great sandy beach and it is the safer "natural port of the island. In the northwest part of Agnonta we meet Limnonari, a small bay with very clean waters, ideal for swimming and water sports. Do not miss going for a swim at Milia and Kastani, from where you can also enjoy a spectacular sunset.

Some people prefer Glossa, a peaceful picturesque village in the north of the island with few tourists, traditional houses and wonderful sunsets. Glossa is the second largest settlement of the island, much quieter but equally beautiful, with an unsurpassed view across Skiathos and Evia.

LOCAL BUS - GETTING AROUND

There are plenty of Public **buses**, which cost between €1.50-€3.00 depending on where you are going. Tickets are bought on the bus. The timetables to and from Skopelos are as follows (During May, June, September and October the last bus is about 18.00):

From Skopelos to Stafylos and Agnondas.

The public buses are operated by the Town of Skopelos and are in no way connected to the Adrina. For your information, total travel time lasts from 30 to 45 minutes depending on the route.

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TAXI SERVICES

There are a few **taxi services** in Skopelos, numbers are detailed below. It is always advisable to book in advance. Please be aware that taxi-sharing is very common in Greece, therefore don't be surprised if you find yourselves sharing a taxi with a total stranger!

It is always best to call for a taxi from the area you are at. If, for example, you are at the port of Skopelos Town, according to the list below you could call Kalogiros Panayiotis.

Caution: The cost from either port to the middle of the island, which is Panormos is approximately 18 Euros.

WATER

Although the tap water is safe, it is best to drink bottled water. It is cheap and available everywhere. Tap water can be used for washing, bathing and brushing your teeth (mind the funny taste).

PARKING

The port has a large free parking space which is behind the taxi station. However, the port can become crowded, so parking can be difficult there. More parking spaces can be found at the end of the port. Please note though that access to that particular part of the port is restricted during the afternoon, and that the same area is a ferry embarking/disembarking point, thus your car can be blocked in due to the large number of cars accessing the area during ferry arrivals/departures.

There is another parking area found next to Elin gas station, near the port. It is further away than the one in the port (and smaller), however it is much less crowded

In general, if your hotel is within walking distance of the town and the port, it is a much better idea to walk.

Please also be aware that parking anywhere other than in designated parking areas is not recommended, as policemen frequently patrol the port and will issue fines.'

NEWSPAPERS

There is a great newsagent next to Platanos Square. It has almost all the European newspapers, as well as books, stamps etc. It is open Mon-Sun: 08:00 - 00:30.

SUPERMARKETS

Skopelos, like most Greek islands, does not have big supermarkets but small mini-markets with a more limited variety. There are plenty around Skopelos. In general, most mini-markets open early in the morning and close late at night during summer months.

Alternatively, there are 2 discount super markets, Both are located on the ring road (on your left hand side) on the way to Stafylos-Agnontas, which can be accessed by car.

MAIL

ELTA is the official name for the Greek postal service. The post office is situated near the port, opposite the internet cafe. Standard stamps can be bought from the post office and from most news agents. For light letters, you can affix the stamp, then deposit the letter in one of the yellow post boxes found in selected areas of the island. There is one post box outside the post office and another one opposite Englezos restaurant (at the port), next to the kiosk. Additionally, there is a post box outside the news agent, next to Platanos Square. For heavier letters, it is better to go to post office to have it weighed, to make sure that it reaches its destination no matter what!

Sending a postcard to ANY destination worldwide costs 0,65 cents.

EXCURSIONS

Tour to Ai Yiannis: A unique place to visit. 23 km from Hora (Skopelos town). After a drive in pine forests you reach the Agios Ioannis monastery (Ai Yiannis). We strongly recommend a visit to the monastery (take care on the stairs) and experience a fantastic view! There is a small beach where you can swim too if you wish.

Aegean Paradise: Sail up the whole eastern coastline of Alonissos, the only inhabited island of Greece's biggest National Marine Park on board their chartered boat. The local guide will tell you more about the island's history as well as show you some of the most spectacular beaches. Then head up to the deserted sacred island of Kyra Panagia with its 13th century Athos-style monastery. The Marine Park is host to many endangered species and also an emigration path. There will be opportunities to swim, top up your tan on the decks and learn more about wild life, the monastic life and the local history of this stunning, precious and natural reserve corner of the Aegean sea. Heading back to Skopelos everybody on board could end the cruise with a last stop at the port of Alonissos (Patitiri) with an optional visit to the Old Chora (town).
